

#### BED-WETTING FOR OVER 30 YEARS!

The Nytone Enuretic Alarm was invented by George H. Balding in the late 1960's. At the time he had a child that was experiencing problems with bed-wetting and he began to search for a solution. Existing systems at the time were cumbersome and would often only sound an alarm after the child had completly wet the bed.

George realized there was a great need for a more effective alarm. He designed an alarm that was to be worn on the wrist with a cord running from the unit, up through the night clothes and down to the underpants. It used a clip that was attached to the outside of the underpants and would sound an alarm at the exact moment that bed-wetting occurred. George experimented with this new design on his bed-wetting child and found that the **conditioning process worked much more quickly** with this new alarm, compared to the bed alarm he previously used. After only a short amount of time his child was cured of bed-wetting and the Nytone Enuretic Alarm was born.

In 1978 a clinical trial was performed by Stephen R. Shapiro, M.D. of the Department of Urology University of California, Davis School of Medicine, using the Nytone alarm. In his article, which is included in this packet, he talks about many different forms of enuresis treatment including the use of drugs, behavioral treatment and conditioning therapy. His conclusion is that using an alarm is the best form of conditioning treatment for enuresis and that when testing the Nytone alarm there was a greater than 80% **success rate**. Around the same time, the Nytone alarm was featured on the television show 20/20 and was received with great enthusiasm.

Several newer versions of the original alarm have since been released with additional features. The newest unit is one of the smallest alarms on the market. The alarm unit is worn on the upper arm with a comfortable elastic band


